WHEREAS, the Solicitor of this district has requested the Commissioners to request a Special Term of Superior Court for Columbus County to begin on Monday, March 31, 1952, for the trial of Criminal and Civil matters, with a grand Jury, due to an accumulation of criminal and civil actions which require the holding of a special term for its dispatch, now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County that the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of N. C. be and he is hereby respectfully requested to call a one-week Special Term of Superior Court for Columbus County for the trial of criminal and civil cases, with a Grand Jury, to begin on Monday, March 31, 1952.

After the passage of the above resolution the contents thereof were transmitted to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, and the commissioners were thereupon informed by Honorable John M. Strong, Administrative Assistant to the Chief Justice, that the Special Term of Court requested ^{had been called by the Chief Justice} as provided by law, with a Grand Jury.
