The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that refund of \$85.07 be made to W. C. Thomas, Tatum Township, as this land was double listed for 1951. --- tax receipt #560.

Ordered: that out door poor for Billy Israel be increased from \$15.00 to \$25.00.

Ordered: that valuation of Elkins Estate Tract listed to E.C. Elkins, Welches Creek Township, be reduced from \$5,893 to \$3,500.

Ordered: that valuation on 1 lot listed to J. W. Vereen, Jr., Bolton Township, be reduced from \$600 to \$300.

Ordered: that the Ben F. Mitchell Heirs Taxes for 1937 and prior years in Waccamaw Township be permitted paid at par and no costs allowed provided all of the remainder of the unpaid taxes against Ben F. Mitchell Heirs in Waccamaw Township are paid.

Ordered: that the 1950 poll tax listed in the name of Thomas G. Suggs Bug Hill Township, be cancelled and tax collector be given release as this man was in service for the year 1950.
