The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That the county pay from the Out Door Poor Fund the balance on bills for Anna Lee Ganeous, Cancer Victim, after all other aids have been exhausted;

Ordered: That the Waccamaw Bank & Trust Company, Whiteville, N. C. be named depository for all school funds and that the First National Bank of Whiteville be named depository for other county funds.

Ordered: That the audit report of the Clerk of Superior Court be approved as presented by S. Preston Douglas, C. P. A., it is further ordered that he be given contract to audit Clerk of Superior Court Funds for the year 1956 at a rate of \$25.00 per day.

Ordered: That Thomas Stanley, Jailer, be allowed expenses to attend the Schools for Jailers in Chapel Hill, N. C. July 11, 12, & 13th .

Ordered: That \$5,000.00 be made available to Whiteville City Schools by January 1, 1957 for use in the purchase of furniture and equipment. It is further ordered that this amount be repaid to the fund from which it was taken from Whiteville City Schools 1957-58 Capital Outlay Budget.

Ordered: That Erusie Gaskins, Tabor City, South Williams Township be given a refund in the amount of \$9.50 and that his valuation on 5 lots now valued for tax purposes at \$2,000.00 be reduced to \$1,500.00 .

Ordered: That B. E. Hughes & James L. Roberts, South Williams Township be refunded on a valuation of \$1,000.00 for the year 1950 as this was also listed to New Tabor Theatre.
