The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That the valuation on property listed in the name of Erusie Gaskin, South Williams Township, be reduced for the year 1956 in the amount of \$500.00 and that the tax collector be given a release.

Ordered: That William Mahoney be paid the balance of his salary which was not paid by the state during the time he was recovering from wounds received during capture of Ellis Brinkley, The amount not to exceed \$200.00

Ordered: That F. B. Foster, plumber, be allowed to install plumbing and fixtures in the County Boarding Home. Contract not to exceed \$750.00.

There was a general discussion on purchase of a stove for the Boarding Home. Action on matter postpone until after January 1, 1957.

Ordered: That the salary of Venie H. Rouse, Asst. Tax Supervisor, be raised from \$240.00 per month to \$250.00 per month. The raise to be retroactive as of July 1, 1956.
