The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That the 1933 and 1934 taxes E. F. Buffkin Estate, Whiteville Township be paid at par.

Ordered: That the county pay the Town of Whiteville \$199.40. This represents one half the cost of an emergency generator for radio power service.

Ordered: That on lot listed in the name of Alma Fields Britt, Tatum Township, valued at \$367.00 be stricken from the tax records due to error in listing, and that the tax collector be given a release on said valuation for each of said years being \$6.97, 1953, 1954, 1955, and 1956.
