The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That \$1,000.00 be allowed the Soil Conservation Service to be used in this fiscal year.

Ordered: That 49 acres of land in Western Prong Township, listed in the name of Howard Tart Heirs, be reduced in value from \$2847 for the years 1954, 1955, and 1956 to \$1500.00 and that the Tax Collector be given a release on a valuation of \$1347 for said years and that the above property be listed for tax purposes at a valuation of \$1500.00 for 1957.

Ordered: That a 3/4 acre tract of land in Western Prong Township, listed in the name of Cecil Thomas, be reduced in value from \$2500 for the years 1954, 1955, and 1956 to \$1500 and that the Tax Collector be given a release on a valuation of \$1000 for said years and that the above property be listed for tax purposes at a valuation of \$1500 for 1957.
