The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That the resignation of V. H. Lytton, Assistant County Agent, be accepted to become effective September 30, 1957.

Ordered: That Luther Broaddus III be hired as Assistant County Agent to replace V. H. Lytton. He is to began work at the same salary.

Ordered: That the resignation of Mary Wade Robinson, Extension Secretary, be accepted effective July 31, 1957, it is further ordered that Eleanor Pridgen be hired to replace Miss Robinson.

Ordered: That the Audit report of funds of Columbus County be accepted as presented by S. Preston Douglas, C. P. A. it is further ordered that he be given contract to audit funds for the year 1957-58 at a rate of \$30.00 per day.

Ordered: That payment of tax certificates for year 1926, 1929, 1931, 1935, 1937 and 1938 for property listed in the name of W. J. Smith, Ransom Township, be accepted at par plus $\frac{1}{2}$ of penalties.

Ordered: That J. C. Godwin, Rt. 1, Clarendon, Williams Township, be refunded the sum of \$4.20 overpayment of 1957 tax due to the value of a 1952 Ford Tractor was erroriously figured as if it were a 1953 tractor.

Ordered: That property listed in name of Derrick Pharmacy in Chadbourn Township be reduced by \$2500.00 due to error in listing stock of Goods & Fiktures at \$7000.00 and should have been \$4500.00. 1954

Ordered: That property listed in the name of Hallsboro Trading Company Bogue Township be reduced by \$36,932 due to error in listing stock of Goods and Fiktures at \$41,035.00 and should have been \$4103.00. 1957

Ordered: That Leroy Young, Tatum Township, be exempted from paying poll tax and that taxes listed by him for years 1946 and 1950 through 1957 be cancelled on account of disability.

Ordered: That one lot listed together with other real estate in the name of B. C. Bailey, Chadbourn Township, valued at \$2,065.00 be segregated and upon payment of taxes due upon said valuation that said lot be released from the lien of taxes for each of the years 1955 through 1957. A proportienate part of personal property tax will be collected.

Ordered: That William Freeman, Bolton Township, be exempted from paying poll taxes and that taxes listed by him for years 1948-1957 be cancelled on account of disability.

Ordered: That 1957 tax on an automobile listed in name of Nancy Hammond, Cerro Gordo Township, be cancelled as this car was properly listed for taxes in Robinson County.

Ordered: That L. V. Holt, Tabor City, N. C. be hired as electrical inspector for the County & City Schools units. The General County Fund shall be reimbursed for this expense by the two school units. He shall began at a salary of \$200.00 per month.

Ordered: That the Chairman & Clerk be authorized to sign Bond Interest and Redemption Fund voucher in the amount of \$505.00 to pay the following debt service due:
