Ordered: That lands listed in the name of George Brown, Ransom Township, for year 1957 be reduced to a total of \$1500.00 and combined as 13 1/4 acres for year 1958, and that the Tax Collector be given a release for 1957 tax on a valuation of \$1364 due to error in valuation of new house and payment on total valuation of \$1500.00 for year 1957 be accepted .

STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA
COUNTY OF COLUMBUS

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County feel that it is both feasible and practical that U. S. highway No. 13, be extended southward from Goldsboro, North Carolina, and be routed over the present U. S. Highway No. 701 from Clinton, North Carolina to Charleston, South Carolina and

Whereas, U. S. Highway 701 meets all requirements of Federal specifications and the extension of U. S. Highway 13, along the present route of Highway 701 would be a mid-way point between U. S. Highways 301 and 13, thus sharing existing burdensome North-South traffic, and also provide a shorter route from the North-East to Southern extremities of the country, and

Whereas, it is felt that U. S. Highway 701, being a short cut-off does not attract the tourist traffic which might be brought through this area with the routing of a Federal Highway, such as U. S. 13, originating in the heavily populated areas of the North-East, and it is believed that resulting tourist traffic would relieve congestion of traffic on U. S. 301

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the North Carolina State Highway Commission be, and is hereby petitioned to indorse and secure the concurrence of Federal Authorities for the extension of U. S. Highway No. 13, to follow the present routing of U. S. Highway No. 701, from Clinton, North Carolina to Charleston, South Carolina, for the overall advantage and convenience of the general public.

A copy of this resolution to be forwarded to the North Carolina State Highway Commission, and that they be urged to designate the present U. S. Highway No. 701, as U. S. Highway No. 13.
