

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office February 3, 1958 at 10 A.M. it being first Monday

The following business was transacted :

Ordered : That the tax collector be given a release of 2.00 for each of the years 1956-1957 covering poll tax listed in the name of Guthrie M. Williamson, Tatum Township. This man is 62 years old.

Ordered : That Guthrie M. Williamson be given a refund for 2.00 poll tax for the years 1947 through 1955. This mans age was listed through error incorrectly.

Ordered : That lands listed in the name of Anna Robinson as 30 acres valued at \$6155 for years 1956-57-58 be reduced to \$750 due to error in valuation of buildings and that the tax collector be given a release on said excessive valuation for the years 1956 and 1957 and that said lands be listed for 1958 at \$750.00

Ordered: That land listed in the name of Dr. M.N. Muldrow, Whiteville Township for the years 1954, 1953, 1954, 1955, 1956, and 1957 valued @ \$55 be released from the lien of taxes for said years upon payment of taxes due on said valuation and the pro-rata part of personal taxes due therein.

Ordered: That the tax collector be given a release on \$2.00 value charged to John Chaster Ward in 1956 and to his heirs in 1957, South Williams Township. Said error was caused by 5 acres being listed as \$1155, which was included in other listings and 11.37 acres @ \$200. and values should be reversed and said 5 acres eliminated leaving 11.37 acers valued @ 1155 for 1958 to John Chester Ward Heirs.

Ordered: That the Chairman and Clerk be authorized to sign bond interest and redemption fund voucher in the amount of \$2,494.48 to pay the following debt service due:
