The following business was transacted:

After a discussion with Dr. C.E. Hartford, Vice President of Reigel Paper Co.
the following order was passed-

Ordered: That agreement which the Board of Commissioners entered into
with Reigel Paper Company on June 29, 1950 stand as is until 1961 when date
of agreement runs out. Voting yes: Thompson, Council, Bartly. Not Voting:
Ward.

Ordered : That seal bids be requested for the Chassis of the New Bookmobile.

The North Carolina Industrial Commission made the following formal award
to Warren B. Roebuck, former Deputy Sheriff of Columbus County:

1. Defendant shall pay compensation to the plaintiff, Warren B. Roebuck,
in the amount of \$1,750.00 in a lump sum without commutation for serious bodily
disfigurement within the meaning of G.S. 97-31 (w), subject to counsel fee here-
inafter allowed.

2. Defendant shall pay all medical bills incident to plaintiff's injury
when submitted to and approved by the Industrial Commission.

3. Defendant shall pay the costs, including expert witness fees of \$15.00
each to Dr. W.F. Barefoot and Dr. W.E. Baldwin, both of Whiteville.

4. A fee of \$200.00 is approved for plaintiff's counsel, Powell, Lee and Lee,
to be deducted from the compensation due plaintiff and paid directly to said
attorneys.

5. No penalty is assessed against the defendant under the provisions of
G.S. 97-94, as defendant has now complied with such section.

Ordered: That lands listed in error as two 15 acres tracts in Bolton
Township for years 1946 through 1957 in the name of J.W. Jacobs be corrected
as 15 acres valued at \$400 for year 1958 and listed to Manley Jacobs and that
payment of all back taxes be accepted at one fifth of amount due by calculation
on present value shown on certificate thereby County over valuation of House
and error as to acreage. And that tax collector be issued release on balance.

Ordered : That taxes listed erroriously in name of P.M. Skipper Ransom
Township be cancelled for year 1953 through 1957 due to being double listed.

Ordered: That payment of taxes due on lands listed in name of Y.N. Gore in Williams Township for the years 1938- 1939 & 1941 be accepted at amount of tax certificate .

Ordered : That payment of taxes due on lands listed in name of J.H. Powell in Whiteville Township for the ~~year~~ years 1934 & 1935 be accepted at amount of tax certificate.
