The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That the Waccamaw Bank & Trust Company, Whiteville, North Carolina be named depository for all school funds and that the First National Bank of Whiteville be named depository for other county funds.

Ordered: That the audit report of the Clerk of Superior Court be approved as presented by S. Preston Douglas, C. P. A., it is further ordered that he be given contract to audit Clerk of Superior Court Funds for the year 1958 at a rate of \$30.00 per day.

Ordered: That the Budget for the year 1958-59 for Whiteville City Schools be approved as presented by L. A. Bruton, Supt.

Ordered: That Kenneth Smith be appointed Constable of Welches Creek Township to serve until the regular election is held in November.

Ordered: That Roosevelt Ivey be appointed Constable of Tatum Township to serve until the regular election is held in November.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Annie Lee Smith Jones, Lees Township, for the year 1957 be cancelled. This property is double listed;

Ordered: That real estate listed in the name of Leo Davis, Whiteville Township, for the years 1951, 1952, 1953 and 1957 and 1958 be reduced in value for each of said years by \$1100.00 due to house burned and replaced house razed.

Ordered: That payment of taxes listed in the name of Penny Durden Estates for years 1923 in Fair Bluff Township & years 1930 through 1934, 1937, 1938 and 1941 in Cerro Gordo Township be accepted at amount of tax certificates without further cost and penalty.

RESOLUTION

At the regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Columbus, State of North Carolina, on the 7th day of July 1958, the following resolution was presented by Lacy R. Thompson and seconded by Dan C. Bartley, and unanimously adopted.

WHEREAS, the United States of America, consistent with the policies and principles of Public Law 875, 81st Congress, 2nd Session, approved a Report of Stream Clearance Investigation for Columbus County of the U. S. Army Engineer District, Wilmington, Corps of Engineers, Wilmington, North Carolina, dated October 25, 1957, and authorized the removal of trees, snags and other debris attributable to hurricanes from existing drainage outlets with said county, more particularly from Gum Swamp, Mill Branch, Western Prong Swamp, Friar Swamp, and Simmons Bay,

AND WHEREAS, the U. S. Army Engineer District, Wilmington, Corps of Engineers, Wilmington, North Carolina, has been directed to prosecute said work of clearing and snagging, as agency of said Government,

AND WHEREAS, the operation conditions of the work as determined by the District Engineer, U. S. Army Engineer District, Wilmington, requires local cooperation on the part of local interests to provide without cost to the United States of America, the free right of egress and ingress to, over, and across adjoining lands to work sites as may be necessary for the orderly execution of the work of clearing and snagging, and hold and save the United States free from damages due to depositing of debris, consisting of snags, trees, logs, and other similar material, upon the lands adjacent to the project locations, provided that no material is deposited upon cultivated fields, all generally within the areas set forth on attached map entitled Federal Civil Defense Adm. Stream Clearing Projects for Columbus County

AND WHEREAS, the said Board of Commissioners being cognizant of the importance and benefit to be derived by the people of Columbus County, growing out of said proposed improvement, desires to guarantee to the United States of America the local cooperation for the aforesaid improvement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the county of Columbus, State of North Carolina, for and in consideration of the work of removal of trees, snags and other debris from existing drainage outlets within said county, more particularly from Gum Swamp, Mill Branch, Western Prong Swamp, Friar Swamp, and Simmons Bay, all consistent with the policies and principles of Public Law No. 875, 81st Congress, 2nd Session and the respective authorized projects contained in Report of Stream Clearance Investigation for Columbus County of the U. S. Army Engineer District, Wilmington, Corps of Engineers, Wilmington, North Carolina, does hereby guarantee to the United States of America, the free right

of egress and ingress to, over, and across adjoining lands to work sites as may be necessary for the orderly execution of the work of clearing and snagging for the projects and hold and save the United States of America free from damages due to depositing of debris, consisting of snags, trees, logs, and other similar material, upon the lands adjacent to the project locations, provided that no material is deposited upon cultivated fields, all generally within the areas set forth on attached map entitled Federal Civil Defense Adm. Stream Clearing Projects for Columbus County.
