The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That the Board approve the appointment of Mrs. Viola C. Baker, P. O. Box 858, Greenville, N. C., as Court reporter. Expenses as provided by the amendment amending Article II, Chapter 7 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, being Senate Bill 542, 1955 Session Laws of N. C.

The agreement as follows:

\$100.00 per week for each scheduled term of Court whether cancelled or not. \$20.00 for each week of Court that is actually attended and \$7.50 per day for each night spent in Whiteville attending Court .

Ordered : That Raymond Earl Batten ,W. Creech Township , be given a refund for \$ 2.00 for poll Tax , due to being in service.

Ordered : That taxes listed in the name of A. C. L. Co. in Fair Bluff and Tatum Township be cancelled due to error in 1957 .

Ordered : That Mr. Waitus Green be Allowed to pay taxes listed in Cerro Gordo Township in the name of E. W. Green for the years 1931 & 1934 at balance on tax sales certificate .

Ordered: That payment of taxes listed in the name of T. L. Gause Cerro Gordo Township for the year 1939 be accepted at the balance of tax sales amount .

Ordered : That lands listed in name of Mrs. Ruth Caldis in Whiteville Township for year 1958 be segregated and the home of Mrs. Ruth Caldis valued at \$1079.00 be released from lien of taxes for 1958 upon payment of taxes due on said valuation plus all personal property listed. The 2 Houses valued at \$1800 being the property of Paul Caldis Estate and were included in above listings through error.

Ordered : Upon motion of Commissioners Council, seconded by Commissioner Thompson and carried it is ordered that the Columbus County Jailer shall file a report with the County Accountant on or before each first Monday showing all persons committed to jail, the Court the individual was tried in, the amount of jail fees due and the disposition made of prisoners.

It is further ordered that all magistrates and mayors shall file a report on or before each first Monday with the County Accountant listing cases where jail fees were collected and shall accompany said report with a check to Columbus County for all jail fees collected .

Ordered : That the Chairman and Clerk be authorized to sign bond interest and redemption fund voucher in the amount of \$2,475.38 to pay the following debt service due :
