Ordered: That The Sheriff proceed to exercise all powers to secure the service of Warrants in other States where abandonment and non-support are charged.

Ordered: That all fire insurance on all County buildings and on all County equipment be evaluated so that a rate can be established to place all policies in one Master policy.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Zeno Best, Lees Township for the years 1926 and 1936 be accepted at Tax certificate value.

Ordered: That Taxes listed in the name of J. A. Knowles for the year 1937-1938 and 1939 in Ransom Township be cancelled as this was a double listing.

Ordered: That a 30 acre tract of land valued at \$165.00 and a 59 acre tract of land valued at \$850.00 that are now listed in the name of J. L. Smith, Whiteville Township be segregated from other lands so that Seth Cartrette now owner of the 30 acre and 59 acre tract can pay taxes on said tracts along with a proportionate part of J. L. Smith's personal property tax for the years 1955-1956-1957 and 1958 and that said lands be released from the lien of taxes for said years.

Ordered: That Tax Collector be given a release for \$35.84 to adjust discount on Carolina Power & Light Company, receipt #187, Chadbourn Towhship.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Franklin Lester Fipps, South Williams Township be Cancelled for the year 1958 due to double listing, receipt # 1519.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Doris Wright Coker, South Williams Township be cancelled for the year 1956, tax receipt #1498. This was due to a car being listed twice.

Ordered: That tax value on property listed in the name of James R. Parker, Waccamaw Township for the year 1958 be reduced from \$2150.00 to \$1500.00 and

and that the Tax Collector be given a refund (12.35) on a \$650.00 valuation .

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Frank and Ambrose Floyd, Cerro Gordo Township for the year 1958 be segregated so that each can pay one half of the total tax.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of J. P. and Elroy Mercer, Williams Township for the year 1958 be cancelled, receipt #1182. This tax was on an automobile and was listed twice through error.
