Ordered: That Jo Anne Vereen, Caseworkers Asst., salary be raised from \$250.00 per month to \$260.00 per month effective February 1, 1959.

There was a general discussion between the County Commissioners, Whiteville City School Board and Representative Edward L. Williamson concerning the replacing of the Whiteville High School that burned.

Upon Motion of Commissioner Buffkin and seconded by Commissioner Thompson and carried it is ordered that the Commissioners call for a County wide Bond issue of \$500,000.00 to be distributed on a per capita basis between the Columbus County and Whiteville City Schools.

It is further ordered that the County Accountant and Clerk to the Board be instructed to file with Mr. W. E. Easterling an application for approval of the issuance of the Bonds and that the Bond attorneys, Mitchell, Pershing, Shetterly and Mitchell, be contacted and requested to provide for the Bond election as soon as possible .
