Ordered: That Gladys R. Dudley be hired as secretary in the County Agents office at a salary of \$35.00 per month.

Ordered: That the legislature be asked to amend S B 162 and H B 331 and schedule Columbus County for a revaluation in 1965 instead of 1961.

Ordered: That a certain road in Ransom Township be abandoned by the State Highway Commission due to lack of ability to obtain right of way described as following. The section to be abandoned from a point .5 mile west of Evergreen church to a point .2 mile from Delco prosper road.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Herman Campbell, Chadbourn township, receipt #1828 for the year 1957 be cancelled. This covered accar listed twice.
