The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That W. B. Buffkin be appointed to serve on the Columbus County Welfare Board to replace Charles R. Council whose resignation became effective June 1, 1959. Mr. Buffkin's appointment effective July 1, 1959.

Ordered: That the Special Levy Fund budget be approved as presented.

Ordered: That the resignation of Mrs. Bulan Singletary, a part time worker in the Tax Supervisors office, be accepted.

Ordered: That the audit report of the Clerk of Superior Court be accepted as presented by S. Preston Douglas, C. P. A., it is further ordered that he be given contract to audit Clerk of Superior Court Funds for the year 1959 at a rate of \$30.00 per day plus travel.

Ordered: That the Budget estimate for 1959-60 as submitted to the Board by Josephine F. Ray, County Accountant be tentatively approved. It is further ordered that a copy of estimate be filed with the Clerk to the Board for Public inspection and that a copy of same be made available to Newspapers in County. As required by law, it is ordered that a notice be run in the Newspaper once to the effect that the budget estimate is on file in the office of the Clerk to the Board of Commissioners.

Ordered: That a road in Whiteville Township from highway 74 & 76 near the County home running 0.54 mile to a point where new location begins be abandoned. The Board also request and urge the State Highway Commission to add to its system .3 mile from Columbus County Health Center Southward to connect Pine-log road.

Ordered: That Henry Bryant, South Williams Township be given a refund of .95 cents. Through error he was charged on \$50.00 valuation twice. Send check to General Delivery Tabor City.

Ordered: That John D. Cribb be allowed to pay taxes listed in the name of W. T. Cribb, Williams Township for the years 1939, 1941, & 1942 at par.
