

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said Office June 20, 1959 at 3:30 P. M. according to adjournment:

The following business was transacted:

Upon Motion of Commissioner Buffkin, seconded by Commissioner Thompson and carried it was decided that the Whiteville High School building which burned on December 17, 1958 should be built back on the old site. That the Commissioners would borrow in the fiscal year 1959-60 \$40,000.00 to be used to replace the burned building & in the fiscal year 1960-61 \$25,000.00 to be used to replace the burned building.

It was felt that this \$65,000.00 with approximately \$76,000.00 for the two years Capital outlay and approximately \$302,000.00 Insurance money should be enough to replace the building and build a better & larger building than the one that burned.

Ordered: That James McGirt, Radio Operator for the Town of Chadbourn, be paid \$20.00 per month from the General County Fund beginning July 1, 1959 for accepting and relaying calls for the Sheriff's Department.

Upon Motion the Meeting was adjourned until June 24, 1959 at 8 P. M.
