The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That the first Monday in July be set as the time for selling property for delinquent taxes.

Ordered: That the Whiteville City School Unit be allowed to use the County Voting Machine for a student body election.

Ordered: That Lee J. Greer, Clerk of Superior Court, be given authority to release the bond of Wilson Griffin to L. P. Ward, Jr. Insurance Agency.

Ordered: That J. T. Wooten, Jr. be recommended for the State Board of Public Welfare's consideration for the State Board's appointee on the County Board of Public Welfare effective July 1, 1960.

Columbus County Board of Health met in joint session with the Columbus County Board of Commissioners and plans for the retirement of Dr. Floyd Johnson, Columbus County Health Director, and the substitution of Dr. J. R. Black in his place were discussed and ordered to be effective July 1, 1960 upon motion of Commissioner Dan C. Bartley and seconded by Commissioner W. B. Buffkin and unanimously carried the Board of County Commissioners authorize Dr. Johnson to employ Dr. Black to carry on his duties and which authorization was approved by the Board of Health at a previous meeting of the Board of Health.

Said orders of approval were made with the understanding that Dr. Johnson would pay from his salary all services rendered for him by Dr. Black and if by reason of absence Dr. Johnson was not entitled to receive any salary the County would pay to Dr. Black in lieu thereof the salary of Dr. Johnson.
