

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office June 6, 1960 at 10 A. M. it being first Monday:

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That the Evening Garden Club be granted permission to plant some shrubbery around County Library this fall.

Ordered: That the portion of County Home property lying just east of the County Home property having a frontage of 300 feet and sufficient depth to contain 10 acres be used by the National Guard Unit in Columbus County as a maintenance shop.

G. S. 155-90 (2) placed a condition on the requirement that the County Accountant countersign warrants on School funds. This condition limits the duty to countersign those warrants accompanied by some document sufficient to satisfy the Accountant that issuance of the Warrant is proper. This does not require the Accountant to file and keep the document after it has served its purpose. The purpose of the 1959 amendment was to give the Accountant specific authority to require proof of the claim before he countersigns the Warrants, and not to require the Accountant to keep a file of supporting documents. This is to be effective July 1, 1960.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of A. J. Bass, Whiteville Township be cancelled for the years 1937 through 1960. This land was sold in 1936 to Dr. Bowman and since has been listed to him.

Ordered: That Poll tax in the name of Edward L. Coleman, Cerro Gordo Township be cancelled for the year 1959. This was listed through error.

Ordered: That Harold Norris, Chadbourn Township be given a refund of \$28.50. Through error his valuation for the years 1957-1958 and 1959 was \$500.00 too high for each of these years. Send check to Harold Norris, Rt. 1 Whiteville, N. C.

Ordered: That a 49 acre tract of land listed in the name of Leonard Carter, Chadbourn Township for the year 1959 be reduced in value by an amount of \$3518.00 and that the Tax Collector be given a release in this amount.
