

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office August 1, 1960 at 10 A. M. it being first Monday:

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That Elmo Covil be appointed to the Riegelwood Sanitary District Board to replace J. D. Daily who moved out of the District.

Ordered: That two men be employed at a rate of \$1.50 per hour 40 hours per week to paint the Boarding Home and do several other misc. jobs.

Ordered: That Carl Hardee be hired as Janitor at the Courthouse Annex. He is to be paid a salary of \$90.00 per month and this amount is to be deducted from the amount paid to Rosier Williams who was Janitor at the Courthouse Annex.

Ordered: That a 30 acre tract valued at \$165.00 and a 59 acre tract valued at \$85.00 owned by Seth R. Cartrette and listed by him for years 1959 & 1960 and listed for years 1955, 1956, 1957, 1958 in name of John Smith in Williams Township, be segregated and upon Payment of Pro Rata Tax due on said lands for said years that same be released from lien of taxes for said years.

Upon Motion of Commissioner Lacy R. Thompson, and seconded by Commissioner Dan C. Bartley, and unanimously passed, it was resolved that it would be to the public interest to convey a portion of the County Home property to the State of North Carolina for such time as said property may be required by the State of North Carolina for military purposes, in the opinion of the North Carolina Armory Commission, or its successor, either for the use of the State of North Carolina or for the use of the United States of America, under the provision of the National Defense Facilities Act of 1950, and pursuant to G.S. Chapter 143, Section 235, said land to have a frontage of 500 feet on U. S. Highway 74-76 and run about 700 feet to the back line of said property, and L. P. Ward, Chairman, and Josephine Ray, Secretary and Clerk to the Board of Commissioners, are hereby authorized and directed to execute a deed to the State of North Carolina for said lands for the uses as set forth above, with the provision in said conveyance that when same shall be no longer required that title shall revert to the County of Columbus, State of North Carolina.

COLUMBUS COUNTY

THIS DEED, made this the 1st day of August, 1960, by the County of Columbus, North Carolina, acting through its Board of Commissioners, consisting of L. P. Ward, Chairman, W. B. Buffkin, Lacy R. Thompson, A. O. Burns and Dan C. Bartley. a body politic and corporate existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of North Carolina, party of the first part, to the State of North Carolina, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH: Whereas, the party of the first part is now the owner in fee simple of certain lands hereinafter upon which it is contemplated that a National Guard Armory will be constructed which will be devoted to the use of the North Carolina Guard, or any similar or successor military organization; and

Whereas, the party of the first part has determined by appropriate resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Columbus, North Carolina, that it would be the public interest to convey said property to the State of North Carolina for such time as said property may be required by the State of North Carolina for military purposes, in the opinion of the North Carolina Armory Commission, or its successor, either for the use of the State of North Carolina or for the use of the United States of America under the provisions of the National Defense Facilities Act of 1950; and

Whereas, the State of North Carolina has agreed to accept such conveyance;

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the premises and pursuant to Chapter 143, Section 235, of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended, the party of the first part has bargained and sold, and, subject to the conditions and agreements hereinafter expressed, does hereby bargain, sell and convey unto the State of North Carolina, and its successors, in fee simple, that certain tract or parcel of land situate in Columbus County, State of North Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the South edge of the right of way of U. S. Highway No. 74 and 76, said beginning point being located 50 feet South of the center line of the hard surface of the said highway, about 2 feet north of and in line with the outside of the fence on the eastern boundary of the Columbus County School Bus Garage area (said fence being a cyclone fence on steel posts set in concrete), said beginning point also being located at a point 949.5 feet measured westwardly along the South edge of said right of way from the center of the 30 foot asphalt road leading in to the County Health Center, and running with the South edge of the right of way of said highway North 84 degrees East 500 feet to a pipe; thence South 9 degrees 58 minutes East and parallel with the said cyclone fence (the interior angle being 93 degrees 58 minutes) 785.5 feet to a stake; thence to and with a fence on the old J. L. Memory line North 86 degrees West (bearing taken from map hereinafter referred to) about 505 feet to a pipe in said fence on the old Memory line and in line with the outside edge of the fence on the eastern boundary of the said School Bus Garage area; thence to and with the outside edge of said cyclone fence North 9 degrees 58 minutes West 698 feet to the beginning, containing 8 acres more or less, and being a portion of the property of Columbus County shown on map by J. A. Thompson, Surveyor, dated 5 September, 1888, and recorded in Deed Book HH, page 80, Columbus County Registry.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the aforesaid property unto the State of North Carolina so long as the North Carolina Armory Commission, or its successor, deems that said property is required by the State of North Carolina or the United States of America for military purposes, or for any purpose set forth in the National Defense Facilities Act of 1950; and upon the condition that when the same shall be no longer required by the State of North Carolina or the United States of America, in the opinion of the North Carolina Armory Commission, or its successor, title thereto in fee simple shall revert to the County of Columbus, North Carolina.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the County of Columbus, North Carolina, has caused this instrument to be executed in its name by its Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, and its corporate seal to be hereto affixed, and attested to by its secretary and Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County duly given, this the day and year first above written.
