Ordered: That removal of the County Library Fund from the General County Fund to a Special Levy Fund be submitted to a vote of the people in the General Election on November 8, 1960.

Ordered: That the Audit report of funds of Columbus County be accepted as presented by S. Preston Douglass, C. P. A. It is further ordered that he be given contract to audit funds for the year 1960-61 at a rate of \$30.00 per day plus reasonable travel and subsistence expense.

Ordered: That Benny Register be appointed Township Constable for Lees Township.

Motion was made by W. B. Buffkin, seconded by Lacy R. Thompson and carried to request Mr. John P. Swain, Secondary Roads Department to revise the 1959-1961 Secondary Road program and earmarked \$26,300.00 reserve fund in Columbus County to take care of the Construction of Secondary Road number 1428 better known as the Evander Holcomb Road.

Ordered: That Taxes listed in the name of Acie Moore Heirs in Welches Creek Township be reduced in value by \$898.00 for each of the years 1959 and 1960. This was an error in the Tax Supervisors Office. The value for 1959 and 1960 should be \$100.00 rather than 998.00.

Ordered: That J. Willard Brown, Western Prong Township be given a refund of 98 cents. A 1950 Ford pickup was valued at \$175.00 and should have been \$125.00.
