The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That October 15, 1960 at 10 A. M. be set as the time for opening bids for radio's for the Sheriffs Department.

Ordered: That Josephine F. Ray, County Accountant, be given a three months leave of absence with pay and that Veneda S. Ray will act as Assistant County Accountant in her absence.

The following were appointed to serve as a local Centennial Committee in Commemorating the 100th Anniversary of the War Between the States.

Ordered: That tax valuation on tax listed in the name of L. E. Inman, Chadbourn Township, be reduced by \$950.00. A 1958 tractor was valued at \$1200.00. He should have listed a 1948 at \$250.00.

Ordered: That James N. Nobles, Chadbourn Township be given a refund of \$4.39. A 1956 tractor was valued at \$1200.00 and should have been valued \$975.00.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Rufus K. Gore, South Williams Township, be reduced in value by \$495.00. A gun was listed through error at \$500.00, should have been \$5.00.

Ordered: That lands listed in the name of Graham Patterson, Whiteville Township, be segregated so that Homer Blackman may pay the 1957-1958 and 1959 tax on a 16½ acre tract of land, valued in 1957 and 1958 at \$512.00 and in 1959 at \$614.00, and that upon payment of said tax this 16½ acre tract be free from lein.

Ordered: That A. T. Soles, South William Township, be given a refund of \$2.00 Poll Tax was charged in two townships.

Ordered: That the valuation on a 10 acre tract of land listed in the name of Rufus Lane, Ransom Township be reduced by \$2440.00 for the year 1960, and that same be listed for 1961 at \$2000.00

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Slade Andrew Guyton in Whiteville Township be cancelled for the year 1960. This car and Poll tax were listed through error.

Ordered: That one lot and house in Town of Chadbourn listed in the name of Benjamin Gerald be reduced to \$205.00 valuation due to error in listing valuation and that the Tax Collector accept \$3.99 as payment in full for 1960 and release

be given Tax Collector for balance of \$17.42.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of E. D. Love, Ranson Township be reduced in value by \$700.00. This was due to an error. 1959.

Ordered: That taxes on 1/2 acre tract of land listed in the name of Mabel D. Powell, Whiteville Township for the year 1960 be cancelled. This property was double listed.

Ordered: That two lots valued at \$660.00 listed with other real estate in the name of Kent Thurston for 1960 be segregated so that he may pay tax on the above two lots. Upon payment of above tax these two lots for said year will be free from tax lein.

Ordered: That Royce T. Register in Lees Township be given a refund of \$2.00 He was charged Poll Tax and was not living in Columbus County as of January 1st.

Ordered: That Glenn Yates, Chadbourn Township be given a refund of \$79.95. this is due to error in listing.

Ordered: That Carolina Savings and Loan be given a refund in the amount of \$78.15 for taxes listed in the name of A. K. Summerlin, Jr. for the year 1960. This tax was paid through error.

Ordered: That the Chairman and Clerk be authorized to sign Bond Interest and Redemption Fund voucher in the amount of \$2,568.91 to pay the following debt service due:
