The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That one Mobile Radio Unit and one Walkie Talkie Unit from the Sheriff's Department be transferred to the Chadbourn Fire & Rescue Squad since these Units can no longer be used on the Sheriff's Departments frequency assignment.

Ordered: That the tentative budget of the Co Operative Health Fund for the year 1961-1962 be approved as submitted.

Ordered: That the County Attorney contact the Local Government Commission in Raleigh in regards to borrowing the maximum amount of money for the benefit of the Whiteville City Schools and Columbus County Schools. \$25,000.00 of the amount borrowed is to be applied to Whiteville City Unit.

Ordered: That \$25.00 from the Out Door Poor Fund be given to Mrs. Fulton Rabon for immediate relief.

Ordered: That Veneda S. Ray, Asst. County Accountant be given a bonus of \$100.00 for overtime work during the first Quarter of 1961.

Ordered: That Taxes listed in the name of John Bracy, Waccamaw Township be reduced in value to \$1,250.00.

Ordered: That Taxes listed in the name of Mrs. A. E. Faulk in Bug Hill Township be cancelled for the year 1927. This was double listed.

Ordered: That Taxes listed in the name of Herbert Graham, Bolton Township be cancelled for the years 1925 through 1939 and that the Tax Collector be given a release for the years 1940 through 1960. The Real Estate was double listed for these years.
