Motion was made by Commissioner Sessions, seconded by Commissioner Buffkin and carried, to accept Hinnant's bid for window units; Schulken's bid for the central unit in the courtroom; and the bid of Waccamaw Electric Co. for the wiring. The total cost of air-conditioning the courthouse will be \$11,894.40

Mrs. Alice Wright, Columbus County Director of Public Welfare, appeared before the Board and submitted a list of administrative expenditures which were to come from additional state and federal appropriation, and which had been approved by the Columbus County Welfare Board. Upon motion made and duly seconded, the Columbus County Welfare Budget was amended to include the following items as submitted by Mrs. Wright:

1. Air-condition the department which will cost approximately \$3,000 to \$3,500. This price includes adequate wiring to handle the air-conditioners.
2. Two desks at a cost of approximately \$125 each.
3. Transcriber.
4. Electric typewriter.
5. Rubber mat for hall.
6. One step salary increase for each professional worker in order to bring salaries in comparison with clerical staff.

Ordered: that the Welfare Director and Surplus Commodities Supervisor begin December 1, 1961 certifying the needy families to receive surplus food.

Ordered: that the salary of county accountant be increased \$50.00 per month effective August 1, 1961.

Ordered: that the salary of Peggy Ruth Greene, clerk to the Surplus Commodities Supervisor, be increased \$5.00 per week effective August 1, 1961.

Ordered: that the Sheriff summon the following good and lawful men and women to serve as jurors for the following terms of court:
