The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that the salary of Daisy Hill, Secretary to the Negro Farm Agent, be supplemented in the amount of \$27.50 for the month of October due to the fact that her application for employment was not processed in the State office in time for her to receive the supplemental salary from the State.

A delegation from the Town of Chadbourn appeared before the Board requesting additional aid from the County in order to employ their radio operator another 8-hour shift. It was ordered that an additional \$85.00 per month be given the Town of Chadbourn for this purpose.

Ordered: that the County budget be supplemented \$850.00 to cover the cost of the above order.

Ordered: that each applicant for surplus commodities be required to furnish the Welfare Department a statement from two reliable persons to the effect that he is in need of such commodities.

Ordered: that an invoice from N.C. Federal Surplus Property Agency, Raleigh, N. C. for surplus generators and other items for use of Civil Defense be paid by the county. It is agreed that the Town of Whiteville will reimburse the county \$7.50 for a file cabinet included in this invoice.

Ordered: that \$15.00 from the Outdoor Poor Fund be given to Mrs. William C. Newton, Rt. 1, Hallsboro, N. C.

The 1961-1962 budget for the Whiteville City Schools Administrative Unit was presented and approved by the Board.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of W. C. Page, Jr., Ransom Township, be accepted at par - these taxes being paid by C. W. Formyduval for the years 1934, 1935, and 1936.

Ordered: that J. A. Batten be given a refund of \$6.00 due to Poll Tax charged through error for the years 1959, 1960, and 1961.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Maxie L. Ross, Lees Township, be segregated so that the taxes for the years 1947, 1948, 1949, 1950, and 1952 through 1961 may be paid on a 54-acre tract of land known as the "Millican" land, and valued for tax purposes at \$407.00 for the years 1947, 1948, 1949, 1950, and 1952 through 1958; valued at \$488.00 for the years 1959, 1960, and 1961. Upon payment of taxes for said years, and a proportionate part of personal property for these years, this 54-acre tract will be free of further lien in the name of Maxie L. Ross.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of James Williams, Ransom Township, be accepted at par for the years 1931, 1932, 1933, and 1934.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Frank Shaw, Ransom Township, be cancelled for the years 1926 through 1934. This was double listed.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Jane Moore, Ransom Township, be cancelled for the years 1924, 1927, 1932, 1933, and 1934. This was taken by the county.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Mrs. Hattie Harris, Ransom Township, be cancelled for the years 1931 through 1935, due to being double listed.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of John Osterling, Ransom Township, be cancelled for the years 1923 through 1937. This was double listed.

Ordered: that a refund be given to Mrs. R. L. Spivey, Williams Township, in the amount of \$2.00 for Poll tax charged after R. L. Spivey's death.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Cole Crawford, Bolton Township, be accepted at Tax Certificate value for the years 1934 through 1942.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Josie Belle Bryant, Ransom Township, be cancelled for the years 1950 through 1961. This was double listed.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Elnora Eady, Estate, Welches Creek Township, be cancelled for the years 1931 through 1943; this was a double listing.

Ordered: that Ernest Paul Hardee, Whiteville Township, be given a refund of \$3.70, due to a 1958 car being listed as a 1959 model.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of I. M. Reynolds, Ransom Township, be cancelled for the year 1946. I. M. Rich was inadvertently charged on the scroll to I. M. Reynolds.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of I. M. Rich, Ransom Township, for the years 1933 and 1937 be accepted at par.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of W. K. Cartrette, Williams Township, on a 12-acre tract of land be segregated for the years 1933 through 1961 so that Novla Cartrette might pay one-half of the total tax and penalty for these years. Upon payment of the above tax, 5 acres of land described in a will given on the 2nd day of January 1931 will be free of further tax lien-- the 5-acre tract to be listed in 1962 at a value of \$286.00 and the 7-acre tract to be listed at \$286.00.
