The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that the county purchase a lot on Smith Street from Jack Saunders at a purchase price of \$6500.00.

Ordered: that two voting machines be purchased for the use of the Board of Elections, Columbus County.

E. L. Green, District Engineer, appeared before the Board and reviewed with the Commissioners their 1962-1963 Secondary Road plans which were unanimously approved.

WHEREAS, the State Highway Commission has filed with the Board of Commissioners of the County of Columbus a map designated as project No. 6432071, SR 1558, and SR # 1157 showing a proposed relocation of a section of county road; and

WHEREAS, it appears that this relocation is for the best interest of the road system of the said county;

NOW, THEREFORE, the proposed change and relocation as shown on the said map is hereby approved and ratified.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of S. W. White, Bolton Township, be cancelled for the year 1926. This was double listed.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of G. W. Jacobs, Sr., Bug Hill Township, be accepted at tax certificate value for the year 1935.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Burris V. Cliff, Chadbourn Township, be segregated so that Ophelia Cliff may be allowed to pay the tax on one lot valued at \$792.00 for the year 1961, and upon payment of above tax and a propertinate part of personal property, this one lot shall be free from tax lien for said year.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Mrs. Minnie High Smith be accepted at tax certificate value for the years 1948 and 1949. This property was listed to the above through error for these years; it should have been listed to Hoke Smith Heirs.

ROAD PETITIONS: 1. Lake Side Drive in Columbus County -- request for addition to the secondary road system.

- ROAD PETITIONS: 2. Road running from County Road #1157 to #1141; is known as "Butler Town" road; 1.5 miles in length and there are 11 occupied homes located on it.
3. Rural Road #1134 in Columbus County; is 2.3 miles in length and there are 28 occupied homes located on it.
4. Road #1908 known as the "Elbow" road; is 2.8 miles in length.
