Ordered: that money be appropriated in the next fiscal year's budget to cover the salary of an additional Public Health Nurse.

Ordered: that land listed in the name of W. K. Ward, Williams Township, be listed in the name of Flossie Stewart Ward.

- ROAD PETITIONS:
1. County road #1735--runs from the unpaved portion of road #1735 to the Rosendale Road on highway #211, is 4.5 miles in length and there are 30 occupied homes located on it.
 2. County Road #1116 in Lees Township-- runs from Poley Bridge Church to Nakina-Tabor City road; is 1.9 miles in length and there are 24 occupies homes located on it.
 3. Road #1427 in Chadbourn Township-- connects #410 and the Peacock road; is 1.2 miles in length and there are 7 occupied homes located on it.
 4. County Road #1925 known as "Ward Town" road; South Lees Township; is 3.5 miles in length and there are approximately 25 occupied homes located on it.
