

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10 a.m., November 5, 1962, it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that T. T. Todd, and S. P. Stanley Jr. be granted a license and the exclusive right to collect and dispose of garbage within a 6-mile radius of Whiteville in accordance with GS 153-272 subject to the regulations promulgated by the State Board of Health and the local Health Department.

Ordered: that the Board approve the closing of Secondary Road # 1119.

Ordered: that John Hines be authorized to purchase from The Family Shoe Store, two pairs of children's shoes not to exceed \$5.00 each, and that The Family Shoe Store bill the County Accountant, Out-Door-Poor fund for this purchase.

Ordered: that \$250.00 be allowed the Lake Waccamaw Fire & Rescue Squadron from the Civil Defense Budget.

Ordered: that the County Attorney be authorized to proceed with the foreclosure of the Porter Huffham Heirs property, Ransom Township, for non-payment of Columbus County Tax.

Ordered: that W. O. Baldwin, Welches Creek Township, be given a tax refund in the amount of \$39.00 due to a house being destroyed by fire in July 1961 and not having been replaced by January 1962.

Ordered: that the Tax Collector be given a release in the amount of \$11.45 on taxes listed in the name of George W. Hooks Heirs, Whiteville Township for the year 1962. This was due to error in listing.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of D. W. Mitchell or D. W. Mitchum, Bogue Township, be cancelled for the years 1922 through 1962.

Ordered: that the Tax Collector be given a release in the amount of \$5.94 on taxes listed in the name of L. C. Suggs, Lees Township, for the year 1962. This was through error in listing.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of J. E. Lyon, Waccamaw Township, be segregated so that Frank Gault may be permitted to pay the 1962 tax on 27 lots valued at \$4,740.00, and that upon payment of tax for the above year, these 27 lots shall be clear of tax lien for the year 1962.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of R. A. Etheridge, Waccamaw Township, Receipt #686, be cancelled for the year 1954. This was double listed.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Thelma Grimsley, South Williams Township, be cancelled for the year 1962. This tax was listed through error to Thelma Grimsley and also to her daughter Patsey Grimsley.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Leo Davis, Whiteville Township, be reduced in value by \$1,322.00 for each of the years 1959, 1960, and 1961 & 1962. An order was made in August 1958, reducing the value through 1958; however, a copy was not given to the Tax Supervisor's office.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Jesse C. Fisher, Jr., Whiteville Township, be segregated so that the Peoples Savings and Loan Association may pay the tax on one lot described as drug store property, valued at \$28,300.00, for the year 1962, and that upon payment of the above tax, this one lot shall be clear of tax lien for the year 1962.
