The following business was transacted:

Bond Resolution for sale of \$1,000,000 School Bonds.

Ordered: that the following Public Assistance Budgets for the Fiscal Year 1963-1964 be tentatively approved as presented by Mrs. Alice S. Wright, Welfare Director: Old Age Assistance, Aid to Dependent Children, and Aid to Permanantly & Totally Disabled.

Ordered: that the Co-operative Health Budget for the fiscal year 1963-1964 be tentatively approved as presented by Dr. J. R. Black, Health Director.

Ordered: that Health Director, Dr. J. R. Black, be authorized to proceed with the construction of a Dog Pound for Columbus County with the use of separate contract labor.

Ordered: that the present lease of the county-owned Rest Home to Mrs. Annie Lou Cowan be extended for a period of two years at a rate of \$10.00 per month per resident; that the county attorney be instructed to draw up a new lease, and that the chairman be authorized to execute said lease in behalf of the county.

Ordered: that the County Commissioners enter into an agreement to rent, at a rate of \$75.00 per month beginning November 1, 1963, a portion of the Tolar Building (Old FCX Bldg.) to Columbus Trading Company; that the county attorney draw up a lease, and that the chairman be authorized to execute same in behalf of the county.

Ordered: that the audit report of all funds and accounts of the Clerk of Superior Court be accepted as presented by S. Preston Douglas, CPA of Lumberton. It is further ordered that the contract of S. Preston Douglas and Associates for this audit be extended for the year 1963 at a rate of \$35.00 per day plus reasonable travel and subsistence expense for the services of each accountant engaged in the work.

Mr. Jesse Fisher Jr., Chairman of the Community College Committee for Columbus County, appeared before the Board to report the progress made by his committee. It was ordered that Mr. Fisher be reimbursed for the expense

incurred to date by his committee, and that a reasonable expense account for this committee be included in the 1963-1964 budget.
