

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10 a.m., February 3, 1964, it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that the salary of Pat Wooten, Supervisor of Surplus Commodities, be increased to \$320.00 per month effective February 1, 1964.

Ordered: that Mrs. Mary Lee Spradley be employed in the office of the tax supervisor beginning in February 1964 at the direction of the tax supervisor.

Ordered: that the Chadbourn Drainage District be advanced \$5,000; said sum to be repaid from assessments of members of the drainage district or federal funds advanced to said district. It was further ordered that this advance be disbursed by the county accountant pursuant to GS 156-61.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Layus D. Green, Ransom Township, be accepted at par for the years 1950 and 1951.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Layus D. Green, Ransom Township, for the years 1953 through 1963 be accepted at one half the amount of tax certificates plus interest, this was due to the house burning on the property.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Humble Oil & Refining Company, Fair Bluff Township, be reduced in value by \$1320.00 for the year 1963. This is due to the real estate value being used twice for the year 1963.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Humble Oil & Refining Company, Ransom Township, be reduced in value by \$5,500.00 for the year 1963. This is due to the real estate value for the year 1963 being included twice.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Willie C. Graham, Fair Bluff Township, be segregated so that S. Scott may be allowed to pay taxes for the years 1952 through 1963 on an 11-acre tract of land, valued for tax purposes at \$396.00, and that upon payment of taxes for said years and a proportionate part of his personal property tax, this particular 11-acre tract shall be clear of tax liens for the above years.

Ordered: that Lamb W. Chauncey, Jr., Waccamaw Township, be given a refund of \$22.00 due to a 1960 Bel Air Chevrolet 8 Cylinder, 4-door, being listed at \$1,920 rather than \$920.00 for the year 1963.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Nelson Price, Whiteville Township, for the year 1963, be reduced by \$21.23. This was due to a 1952 Studebaker, 2-door, 6 cylinder, being listed in error as a 1962 Studebaker.

Ordered: that Lacy Tate be given a refund of \$40.14 on a valuation of \$658.00 for the years 1961, 1962, and 1963. This was due to one lot being erroneously listed twice at the above value for said years in Chadbourn Township.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Jim F. Long, Williams Township, be accepted at par for the years 1949 and 1950.

G. G. Wyrick, Acting District Geologist of Raleigh, N. C., appeared before the Board to discuss the proposal of a ground water survey of Columbus County. Said proposal is a 4-year study at a cost of \$26,000 per year, one-half of said amount to be paid by the federal government, and the balance by Columbus County. The county attorney was instructed to investigate the possibility of securing matching funds from the North Carolina Department of Conservation and Development.

- ROAD PETITIONS:
1. Whiteville Township: Road is .6 mile in length and is the access road to Whiteville Manufacturing Company. There are 3 industries located on it.
 2. Bug Hill Township: Road #1943; is one mile in length and is known as the Old Reaves Ferry Road. There is one occupied home on it.
 3. Ransom Township: Streets in the town of Delco as follows: South Front Street from the Prosper road to Kaiser Street, and Burnham Street from Kaiser Street to Dew Oil Company.
 4. South Williams Township: Road #1128, is 1.3 miles in length and is known as the New Life Road. There are 14 occupied homes on it.
 5. South Williams Township: Road #1130 from New Life Church to Iron Hill road #1006; is .8 mile in length and there are 8 occupied homes on it.
 6. Fair Bluff Township: Road known as the Lovett and Grainger; Secondary #1356. Road is 2.4 miles in length and there are 27 occupied homes on it.

Ordered: that the chairman and clerk be authorized to sign bond, interest, and redemption fund voucher in the amount of \$5,169.16 to pay the following debt service due:
