Waccamaw Township: Extension of Secondary Road #1725 known as the Rosendale Road; is 3/4 mile long and there are three occupied homes on it.

During this week, newspapers and television and radio stations serving the county should acquaint the people of the county with the contribution being made by industry. In turn, the people of the county should, as individuals, express their appreciation to the owners, managers, and employees of industry for this contribution.

The leaders in each of the various communities in the county are encouraged to designate a day during Industry Appreciation Week, at which time the community may, as it deems appropriate, recognize the contribution of its own industry.

RESOLUTION OF BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF COLUMBUS COUNTY, N. C.,
ENDORING FLOOD CONTROL IN WHITE MARSH, COLUMBUS COUNTY, N. C.

WHEREAS, White Marsh is one of the main tributaries of the Waccamaw River with its head beginning in Brown Marsh, Bladen County, near Clarkton and flowing southwardly within a short distance of Whiteville and entering the Waccamaw River at its mouth near Old Dock. Also, a prong known as Pine Log branches off and borders the city of Whiteville on the south heading up near Chadbourn, and

WHEREAS, periodically floods arise within the watershed which seriously damage and curtail the production of agricultural products, and

WHEREAS, it may be feasible to provide improvements for the purpose of alleviating flood damages to the valuable agricultural lands in the basin, and

WHEREAS, the approximate 16,000 people living within the watershed will benefit greatly from the reduced health hazards that are caused by the flooding conditions of White Marsh and its tributaries, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners are satisfied that construction of facilities or improvements that may be made are economically justified and that the County of Columbus and a large portion of its people will thereby receive substantial benefits, both monetary and health, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Commissioners of Columbus County North Carolina, go on record as endorsing improvements of White Marsh Swamp and its tributaries as may be found feasible and economically justified by the Corps of Engineers, U. S. Army.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County of Columbus will provide the necessary local cooperation as required for such projects which are constructed under the authority of Public Law 685, 84th Congress.
