Ordered: that the county accept the offer of Jesse Fisher to furnish free office space for a community service worker until such time as office space is available in a county-owned building. Said worker is available to Columbus County from a grant to North Carolina by the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare. It is understood that no matching funds are required from the county, but that the county must provide office space for a worker.

Ordered: that the courthouse offices be closed on Election Day, Saturday, June 27, 1964.

Ordered: that the salary of Horace Shaw, Superintendent of the County Bureau of Identification be increased \$20.00 per month effective July 1, 1964.

Ordered: that George White be appointed Chadbourn Township Constable upon the resignation of Constable J. C. Todd.
