Ordered: that James C. High, Publisher of the News Reporter, Whiteville, N. C. be appointed to a Steering Committee for the purpose of promoting the Highway #74 Project.

Ordered: that \$160 travel allowance per month for the Dog Warden be incorporated in the 1964-65 Budget.

Ordered: that the tax collector and the county attorney be instructed to proceed with the legal action necessary for the collection of all delinquent taxes in excess of \$500.00

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Mrs. H. C. Blake, Ransom Township, be segregated for the year 1964 so that the tax may be paid on an 85-acre tract, valued for tax purposes at \$1,020.00, and that upon payment of the above tax, this 85-acre tract shall be clear of tax lien for said year.

Ordered: that Mrs. A. M. Anderson, Fair Bluff Township, be given a refund of \$2.00 for Dgg Tax erroneously charged in the year 1963.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of A. Brooks, Williams Township, be accepted at par for the years 1931 through 1949.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Willie C. Graham, Fair Bluff Township, be segregated so that Sam Scott may be allowed to pay the tax on an 11-acre tract of land, valued for tax purposes at \$330.00 for the years 1952 through 1958, and at \$396.00 for the years 1959 through 1963, and that upon payment of the above tax and a proportionate part of his personal property tax, this 11-acre tract shall be clear of tax lien for the said years.
