A ballot shall be furnished to each qualified voter at said election. The ballot for those who vote in favor of this Article shall contain the words "For the act to aid in the development of the County of Columbus, North Carolina", and the ballet for those who vote against this Article shall centain the words "Against the act to aid in the development of the County of Columbus, North Carolina." If and when this Article One, Chapter 158, of the North Carolina General Statutes shall have been approved by the voters of Columbus County, North Carolina, than and thereafter the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County may raise the taxation and appropriate monies within the limits and for the purposes specified in Article One of Chapter 158 of General Statutes of North Carolina.
