

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10 a.m., September 8, 1964, Monday, September 7, 1964 being a legal holiday.

The following business was transacted:

WHEREAS, it is recognized that there is a great need for industrial growth in Columbus County so as to retain and increase its population, taxable property, agricultural industries and business prospects;

THEREFORE, upon motion made and duly seconded, the following order was unanimously passed:

That a special election be held throughout Columbus County between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 6:30 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, on Tuesday, November 3, 1964, for the approval of Article One of Chapter 158 of North Carolina General Statutes; that a supplemental registration of the voters be held from 9:00 a.m. to sunset on each Saturday beginning October 10, 1964 and closing on October 24, 1964. Notice of the registration of the voters and of the election shall be given, the voters shall be registered, the election shall be held, the returns shall be canvassed and the results shall be determined, declared and published under and pursuant to the provisions of North Carolina General Statutes 160-387. A ballot shall be furnished to each qualified voter at said election. The ballot for those who vote in favor of this Article shall contain the words "For the act to aid in the development of the County of Columbus, North Carolina", and the ballot for those who vote against this Article shall contain the words "Against the act to aid in the development of the County of Columbus, North Carolina." If and when this Article One, Chapter 158, of the North Carolina General Statutes shall have been approved by the voters of Columbus County, North Carolina, then and thereafter the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County may raise the taxation and appropriate monies within the limits and for the purposes specified in Article One of Chapter 158 of General Statutes of North Carolina.

Upon motion made and duly seconded, the county attorney was instructed to draw lease agreement to Richard C. Arp. Chairman L. P. Ward was authorized to execute said lease in behalf of the Board of Commissioners.

Ordered: that Leo Herring be appointed Cerro Gerdo Township Constable to replace Harvey Wallace who has resigned.

Ordered: that Daisy A. Hill, Extension Office Clerk, Negro Work, be granted maternity leave, and that a substitute clerk be secured for the month of November only.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Herbert Riggins, Bolton Township, be accepted for payment on the following valuations plus Poll Tax and penalty for said years: 1955 - \$100; 1956, 1957, and 1958 - \$1,100; 1959 - \$1,310; 1960 - \$1,600; 1961 - \$1,310; 1962 - \$1,700; 1963 - \$1,940; and 1964 - \$1,250, and that the tax collector be given a release on the remaining valuation for said years. This was due to an error in listing.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of W. O. Simmens, Chadbourn Township, for the year 1964, be reduced in value by \$1,298. A 1960 Ford, 4-door Galaxie was listed as a 1964 Ford, 4-door Galaxie through error.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Lottie Godwin Cartrette, Williams Township, for the year 1964, be reduced in value by \$1,114. A 1960 Ford Fairlane was erroneously listed as a 1964 model.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of J. G. Worrell, Whiteville Township, be segregated so that taxes may be paid for the year 1964 on a 28-acre tract of land, valued at \$661.00, and that upon payment of said tax, this 28-acre tract shall be free of lien for the year 1964.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Joe B. Barefoot, Bogue Township, be reduced in value for the year 1964 by \$9,500. This was due to an error in listing the value of a new house.

Ordered: that Mack Canady, Lees Township, be given a refund of \$23.50. This was due to a new house being listed at \$3,000 rather than \$2,000 for the year 1964. Send check to Mack Canady, Nakina, N. C.

Ordered: that the tax collector be given a release on a valuation of \$1,290.00 for taxes listed in the name of James Linton Bullard, Chadbourn Township, for the year 1964. A 1962 Chevrolet car was listed through error. Mr. Bullard did not have this car on January 1st.
