

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10 a.m., October 5, 1964, it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that the license tax be waived on a Columbus County Shrine Club sponsored circus which will perform in the county on October 13th.

Ordered: that the salary of Mrs. Venie H. Rouse, Assistant Tax Supervisor, be increased \$15.00 per month, effective October 1, 1964.

Ordered: that the salary of Leo L. Fisher, Register of Deeds, be increased \$25.00 per month effective October 1, 1964.

Ordered: that the courthouse offices be closed on General Election Day, November 3rd, as requested by W. N. Peal, Chairman of the Board of Elections.

Ordered: that the tenant house on the county farm be leased to Leaman Long @ \$30.00 per month, and that Chairman L. P. Ward be authorized to execute said lease in behalf of the county.

Ordered: that County Attorney, Sankey W. Robinson be paid five per cent (5%) commission on prior taxes collected through consultations.

It came to the attention of the Board that two orders had been executed by Judge W. A. Johnson, one ordering the county to pay to Attorney Benton Walton III \$150.00 for services in a habeas corpus proceeding, and one ordering that Attorney Walter H. Powell, Jr. be paid \$125.00 for representation in a writ of review. Sankey W. Robinson, County Attorney, advised the Board that, in his opinion, the Board was not authorized to expend county funds in such matters. Whereupon motion made and duly seconded, County Attorney Sankey W. Robinson was authorized to take any action necessary to determine the validity of said orders.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Herbert R. Graham, Bolton Township, be reduced in value for the year 1964 by \$3,000. A Shell home, 5 rooms and bath, was valued for tax purposes at \$4,000 through error.

Ordered: that Ralph Register, Lees Township, be given a refund of \$4.94 due to a 1962 Ford one-half ton pick up being listed as a 1963.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Annie Elkins and Elsie Elkins, Whiteville Township, be reduced in value for the year 1964 by \$1,900. A 1963 Oldsmobile was erroneously listed rather than a 1953 Buick.

- ROAD PETITIONS:
1. Cerre Gorde Township: Secondary Road # 1501 known as the "Loop Road"-- North of Porter Swamp Church; leads off H.Way 76 and comes back to H.Way 76.
 2. Bug Hill Township: Extension of Waccamaw River Road #1940; 1.5 miles long, 8 occupied homes. Request that road be made 1200' from river bank-- it is now a trail along the river bank.
 3. Western Prong Township: Road running from H.Way 701 to George W. Elkins farm, is .5 mile in length and there are 5 occupied homes located on it.
 4. Ransom Township: Secondary Road #1825. There are 15 occupied homes on the road; 1.5 miles in length.
 5. Whiteville Township: Secondary Road #1551; is 1 mile long and there are 5 occupied homes on it.
 6. Tatum Township: Extension of County Road #1532 from a dead end to County Road #1537 at N.East corner of the Research Station; is .3 mile long; 2 occupied homes located on it. All right-of-way is on state land.
 7. Whiteville Township: "Mary Lane" in Baldwin Woods; is .1 mile and there are 7 occupied homes located on it.
 8. Ransom Township: Road known as the "Burns Road"-- is 0.28 miles in length and there are 3 occupied homes located on it. (Map Attached.)

The following resolution was introduced and was unanimously adopted:

RESOLUTION ENDORSING \$100 MILLION STATE SCHOOL BONDS

WHEREAS, adequate public school buildings, as well as qualified teachers and up-to-date courses, are necessary ingredients of a sound public school system; and

WHEREAS, the construction of necessary public school buildings is imposing an ever-larger burden on county property taxes and county property taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly has offered to help counties meet this burden by authorizing the issuance of \$100 Million in State School Bonds, subject to the approval of the voters at the General Election on November 3; and

WHEREAS, if these State School Bonds are approved on November 3, the public schools

of Columbus County will receive the sum of \$1,291,025.78 for use in building additional school buildings when they are needed; and if these State School Bonds are not approved, the taxpayers of Columbus County will have to raise this amount from property taxes; and

WHEREAS, this amount and more will be necessary in the immediate future if the children of Columbus County are to have adequate buildings in which to study and prepare for a productive role in the life of their community, the county, and the State;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS of Columbus COUNTY that the State School Bonds be and they hereby are heartily endorsed, because they will help provide the additional school buildings that our children need.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all the voters of Columbus County be and they are hereby urged to vote FOR the issuance of these State School Bonds at the General Election on November 3.
