The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that the Board of Elections be allowed to use the Auditor's Office for the tabulation of election returns on November 3, 1964 under the supervision of Commissioner Lacy R. Thompson.

Upon the request of A. L. Duke, Sheriff, a motion was made by Commissioner Buffkin, seconded by Commissioner Sessions, and unanimously carried, to appoint Ernest S. Jacobs as constable for Bolton Township.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of J. C. Fisher in Whiteville Township, be segregated so that Carolina Savings and Loan may be allowed to pay on one lot, valued for tax purposes at \$28,300 for the year 1964, and that upon payment of the tax, this lot be free and clear of lien for said year.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of John T. Tyree, Lees Township, be accepted at par for the years 1943 through 1952.

Ordered: that taxes listed in South Williams Township in the name of Sinclair Refining Company be cancelled for the year 1964. This personal property was also listed through error in Whiteville Township.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Burshell Meares, Fair Bluff, be accepted at par for the years 1925 through 1952.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Dan J. (D. J.) George, Whiteville Township, be cancelled for the years 1930 through 1964. This was double listed. √
