The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that the Register of Deeds be authorized to remove certain Real Estate Index Books from his office for necessary repairs.

Ordered: that the Dog Warden be allowed a maximum of \$15.00 per month for miscellaneous labor.

Ordered: that all courthouse employees be relieved of Saturday morning duties effective February 1, 1965.

There was a discussion regarding an Industrial Development Advisory Committee, and it was agreed that each commissioner should name six members to serve on this committee, and that a list of the members be incorporated in the minutes of the next meeting.

Ordered: that rooms six, seven, eight, nine, ten, and eleven (6,7,8,9, 10 & 11) in the West Wing of the old County Rest Home Building be assigned to the Soil Conservation Director, Frank Glover.

Ordered: that real estate listed in the name of Fred Simmons, Tatum Township, for the year 1964 be reduced from \$3,040 to \$2,340 and that the tax collector be given a release on a \$700 valuation.
