

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10 a.m., June 7, 1965 it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted;

Ordered: that Sam Koonce of Chadbourn be reappointed to the Southeastern Community College Board of Trustees.

Ordered: that the Whiteville Country Club, Inc., under the direction of Dr. Samuel H. Whitehead, and the Star-Lite Theatre, under the direction of Marion Davis, be authorized to exhibit, use, and discharge fireworks at a public celebration of Independence Day, July 3rd or July 5th, on the premises of said County Club and said Theatre. It is understood that such exhibition shall be limited to aerial display type fireworks and shall not include firecrackers or any type of heavy explosives.

Ordered: that Commissioner Lacy R. Thompson be appointed to the Columbus County Welfare Board for a term of three years beginning July 1, 1965 and ending June 30, 1968.

Ordered: that money be appropriated in the 1965-1966 fiscal year's budget to hire an additional deputy sheriff.

Ordered: that all county offices be closed July 5th in recognition of Independence Day which is Sunday, July 4th. It was further ordered that the regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners be held on Tuesday, July 6th, at 10 a.m.

Ordered: that J. Hubert Norris be appointed Tax Collector and Tax Supervisor effective July 1, 1965 and that he be required to furnish Surety Bond in the amount of \$40,000. It was further ordered that surety bond of W. A. Weir be cancelled as of June 30th.

R. C. Soles, Sr., Chairman of the County Planning Board, several members of the Advisory Board, and Victor Denton of the N. C. Dept. of Conservation and Development appeared before the Board to report developments regarding the proposed Zoning Ordinance for the Southeastern Community College Area. A public hearing on these proposals was scheduled for 2 p.m., June 25th.

Ordered: that the County Schools' Budget for the fiscal year 1965-

1966 be approved as presented by County Superintendent of Schools, T. Ward Guy.
