The Board met jointly with State Jail Inspector Smith, former Inspector Early, Sheriff Duke, County Jailer Williams, F. M. Glover, Jr., Foreman of the Grand Jury, and Hamilton H. Hobgood, Judge Presiding at Columbus County Superior Court. There was a discussion of conditions existing at the County Jail. No action was taken.

The Sheriff was instructed to reduce the number of occupants in the jail to at least the number of beds available and to have the wiring inspected by a competent inspector, also to request that the Fire Marshall make an inspection as soon as possible, and to use whatever means are necessary to have the jail immediately cleaned.
