The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that the following persons be appointed to serve as a committee to investigate the possibility of Columbus County's receiving federal funds for beautification of the county:

Jesse Fisher, Whiteville
 Jack Council (John M. Jr.) Wananish
 Bobby Jordan (Harry L.), Rt. 2, Clarkton
 Wayne Miller, Rt. 3, Tabor City
 Buell E. Lanier, Chadbourn

It was further ordered that Jesse Fisher be named temporary chairman of this committee.

Ordered: that the Whiteville High School be granted permission to use voting machines from the courthouse in their school election on April 12th.

Ordered: that the Office of Economic Development be requested to place Columbus County on the appropriate list of counties eligible to receive funds under the Economic Development Act.

Ordered: that the chairman be authorized to write Highway Commissioner Carl Meares of Fair Bluff regarding a request from the Town of Tabor City for curb and gutter from the Tabor City Town limits to the South Carolina line.

Ordered: that advertising cost of delinquent taxes be set at \$1.00 per delinquent taxpayer listed in said advertisement.

Ordered: that the chairman be authorized to write a letter to the Corps of Engineers, Charleston, S. C. requesting them to consider the entire Waccamaw River Water Shed for flood control and possible drainage instead of the original request of the main stem.

Ordered: that the Register of Deeds be authorized to destroy, according to law, certain old records as approved by the Department of Archives & History.

Ordered: that all departments be directed to present their budget requests not later than May 2nd.

Whiteville City Schools Superintendent C. W. Duggins, Chairman of the Board C. Bion Sears, and member Lawrence Bowers, appeared before the Commissioners and stated that the

Whiteville City School Board needed an additional \$50,000 to go forward with their new elementary school on the Chadbourn highway. The county attorney was instructed to contact the Local Government Commission regarding a State Literary Loan for this purpose.

Mrs. Alice S. Wright, Welfare Superintendent, requested that the furnace in the County Hall be carefully inspected and that any necessary major repairs be made during the summer months. It was brought to their attention that this furnace has given quite a bit of trouble during the year and there have been several days when the Welfare Department was without heat. The buildings superintendent, J. Hubert Norris was authorized to attend to this work.

Mrs. Nellie P. Strother, a representative of the N. C. Local Government Employees' Retirement System, discussed with the Board the merits of Columbus County enrolling its employees in the retirement system, pointing out costs to employer and employee. The county health director and welfare superintendent were instructed to estimate the cost to the county of the retirement system for their departments.

Mr. Sherman T. Rock, Attorney at Law, of Morehead City, N. C. appeared before the Board and advised that he represented Mr. LeRoy Stocks and other individuals concerning their dissatisfaction with the revaluation of property in Columbus County, and discussed with the Board the methods by which value was placed upon crop allotments during the revaluation. After answering questions presented by Mr. Rock, the Board advised him that all public records in their office were available for examination by him or any other interested citizen.

Ed Williamson, Attorney for the Board of Education, along with the Superintendent and Members of the Board, appeared before the Commissioners and requested authority to transfer funds from unbudgeted capital outlay balance in order to supplement funds with which to purchase the Stanley Site for the construction of South Columbus Consolidated High School. There was a discussion from members of both Boards and their attorneys, and it was pointed out by R. C. Soles, Jr., who represented the county, that the only interest of the County Board of Commissioners in the matter was to determine the fair value of the proposed site, and that they were not interested, and would not consider sites as such.

A motion was made by Com. Thompson, seconded by Com. Watts and duly carried that said request of the Board of Education for transfer of certain capital outlay funds be recognized, and that the Attorney for the Board of Education, the Superintendent, and Chairman of the Site Committee meet with the County Board of Commissioners to consider all elements as to value and make a determination. It was agreed that the meeting would be held at 9:30 a.m., April 12th.

The chairman and clerk were authorized to sign Bond, Interest, and Redemption Fund voucher in the amount of \$11,601.47 to pay the following debt service due May 1, 1966:
