The meeting was called to discuss and again review the proposed 1967-68 budget. The auditor was instructed to rework the budget using a valuation of \$122,000,000 and a collection rate of 83%, setting the tax rate at \$1.49. It was ordered by Comm. Gore with the approval of Comm. Watts & Comm. Williamson that the tax levy on the Economic Development Fund be reduced from 4.8¢ to 3 ¢.
