

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10 a.m., August 7, 1967 it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

Bids for the Sanitary Sewer Extension for the Highway Patrol Station were accepted by the Board and contracts were returned by mail to Speros Construction Company, Maxton, North Carolina.

A member of S. Preston Douglas & Associates, Lumberton, North Carolina, presented the annual audit report for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1967, and it was ordered that this report be accepted as presented. It was further ordered that said firm be awarded the contract to audit the county funds for the fiscal year 1967-1968 at a rate of \$45.00 per day for the services of each accountant engaged in the work.

After a discussion concerning mass meetings in the courtroom, it was decided that all public meetings are to be held in the Courthouse Annex L. Mr. C. D. Raper will be in charge of appointments for use of this building.

Judge Edward B. Clark met with the Board to discuss the new Jury system. He pointed out that this would consist of a three member commission appointed by the Resident Judge, Clerk of Superior Court, and Board of County Commissioners. Motion was made by Commissioner Burns, seconded by Commissioner Watts that members of this commission be paid at a rate of \$20 per day for each day actually engaged in work with the commission. It was further ordered that the Resident Judge, Clerk of Superior Court and Board of County Commissioners agree in principal that a member of the Negro race be appointed to this commission. It was agreed that the Board of County Commissioners make the Negro appointment.

Motion was made by Commissioner Roland Gore, seconded by Commissioner H. J. Watts that Lee J. Greer, Clerk of Superior Court, be authorized to confer with Leo Fisher, Register of Deeds, to place an order for the pasteboard tabs, index cards and filing cabinet to be used in establishing the new Jury system.

Sanky Robinson and Dick Proctor, members of the Columbus County Bar Association appeared before the Board to commend the Commissioners for improvements made to courtroom.

Mr. C. D. Raper, County Extension Chairman, met with the Board to discuss the resignation of Eleanor P. Pridgen effective September 15, 1967 and to request that she be paid through October 15, 1967 due to annual leave accumulated. Motion was made by Commissioner Gore, seconded by Commissioner Watts that Mrs. Pridgen be paid through October 15, 1967. It was further ordered that the salary which is in the budget for a Negro Secretary be applied to the salary of the secretary who will replace Mrs. Pridgen and to other secretaries now working. Mr. Raper feels the position of a Negro secretary is no longer needed.

A delegation consisting of members of the Columbus County Board of Education with John J. Hicks as spokesman, appeared before the Board to make a formal request for consideration concerning property adjoining the county school bus garage property. The Columbus County School Board stated they would like to use this property for a new administrative building later adding a maintenance building and warehouse at back. The Commissioners spoke favorable of this but a definite decision will be made later.
