The following business was transacted:


Ordered: that the Town of Fair Bluff be allowed to display fireworks on December 21, 1968.


Mr. John T. Morrisey, counsel for the North Carolina Association of County Commissioners appeared before the Board regarding the method by which property is to be listed on abstract forms. After a lengthy discussion on a method of computing an exemption from personal property, a recommendation was made by Mr. Morrisey and is as follows "..... take the appraised value of personal property; give the \$300 exemption and apply the 60% ratio on total." The following action was taken by the Board.

Upon motion made by Commissioner Williamson and seconded by Commissioner Burns and unanimously adopted it was ordered that the 1969 abstracts shall reflect the appraised (100%) value of personal property to be listed and an exemption of \$300 shall be applied to items 18 through 39 on said abstracts. The 60% ratio shall be applied to the total.

The meeting was then adjourned until December 2, 1968 at 10:00 A.M.
