
The following business was transacted:


The Board met to discuss the Capital Outlay Fund budget of the Columbus County Board of Education for the fiscal year 1969-1970. The Board of Education had earlier requested an additional \$67,000 for the Capital Outlay budget to be used to renovate several county school buildings this summer. After a lengthy discussion on the Capital Outlay budget the following action was taken.

Upon motion made by Commissioner Edward W. Williamson, seconded by Commissioner W. O. Johnson it was ordered to increase the Capital Outlay budget of the Columbus County Board of Education for the fiscal year 1969-1970 by \$67,000 above the approved Capital Outlay budget for 1968-1969.

Upon motion the meeting adjourned until May 5, 1969 at 10:00 A.M.
