Ordered: that the balance of \$83.98 from Chadbourn Drainage District be transferred to the General County Fund to close account.

Ordered: that \$37.74 be cancelled from the General County Fund on Prepaid Insurance for W. B. Buffkin.


Ordered: that the Deputy Sheriff's receive 8¢ per mile for out of county travel.


Ordered: that the salary of the County Accountant remain at \$500 per month and delete all travel. However, 10¢ per mile for additional meetings, etc. is authorized.

Johnson, it was ordered that the tax rate for Columbus County for the fiscal year 1969-70 be set at \$1.70, out of which \$1.0230 is designated for school purposes with a balance distributed among all other agencies and departments as approved.
