

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10:00 A.M., November 3, 1969, it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

The minutes of the October 20th meeting were read and approved.

Ordered: that a contribution of \$10 be made to Caswell Training School, Kinston, N. C., to help defray the cost of a Christmas Party.

Ordered: that a check in the amount of \$100 be written to White Marsh-Red Hill Community Center for rent due from use of building from 1965-1969.

Ordered: that a check in the amount of \$25 from the Out Door Poor Fund be written to Rita Judson, Route 1, Whiteville, N.C..

Members of the Jury Commission asked the Board to review and mark capable jurors in their various townships as soon as possible.

J. Hubert Norris, Tax Collector appeared before the Board and reported on the collection of current and back taxes.

A member of the Tabor City Rescue Squad reported to the Board on various systems used in other counties to compensate rescue squads. The Board stated at this time funds were not available to assist further for this fiscal year, however if the rescue squads in the county would get together and agree on an over all amount needed for operational expenses, that the Board would consider this amount and try to work out a more feasible distribution of funds for the next budget year.

Upon motion made by Commissioner Gore and seconded by Commissioner Johnson the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS, Mr. S. T. Enzor, County Building Inspector appeared before the Board and presented a schedule of Building, Plumbing and Inspection Fees which had been heretofore adopted by the Columbus County Housing Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Columbus County Housing Authority and the County Building Inspector recommends that the schedule presented to the Board of

Commissioners be adopted and approved by the Board of Commissioners.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners does hereby adopt and approve the schedule of permits for Plumbing and Inspection Fees as heretofore adopted by the Columbus County Housing Authority; a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part of this resolution and the Building Inspector and Columbus County Housing Authority are hereby authorized to enforce the said fees immediately.
