Ordered: that Christmas holidays for county employees begin on Wednesday, December 24th and that work will be resumed on Monday, December 29, 1969.

The Tax Supervisor and Board of Commissioners will meet at 10:00 A.M., December 17, 1969, in the office of the Tax Supervisor with all Tax Listers for the purpose of issuing appropriate materials and instructions for listing in the month of January.

Ordered: that the Chairman and Clerk be authorized to release the December salary checks of county employees, December 19, 1969.

Ordered: that Mr. Horace Shaw, Supt. of Bureau of Identification, be given a supplement allowance in the amount of \$50 per month for travel

and office expense beginning December 1, 1969 through June 30, 1970.

This is expressly not salary and is not to be considered as an salary increase.

Mr. Buell Lanier, Coroner for Columbus County, appeared before the Board to request a radio for the use of the coroner. Total cost of radio and installation was quoted at \$826.00. It was noted funds were not available in the Coroner's budget and the Board stated a thorough review of the General County Fund would have to be made before the radio could be purchased.

Upon motion made by Commissioner J. Roland Gore, seconded by Commissioner Edward W. Williamson, and unanimously adopted that Mr. H. J. Watts be reappointed Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners for the year 1970 and Mr. Edward W. Williamson be reappointed vice-chairman.

Upon motion made by Commissioner J. Roland Gore, seconded by Commissioner Edward W. Williamson and unanimously adopted that all county personnel be reappointed for the year 1970, and that surety bonds of various employees be approved as recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds and the Clerk of Superior Court.

Upon motion of Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Commissioner T. E. Burns and unanimously adopted that Daniel C. Faulk be appointed constable of Western Prong Township upon failure of the voters of said township to elect a constable as required by General Statutes 151-1. Said constable is to serve in that capacity until next election.

Ordered: that the surety bond be approved for Daniel C. Faulk, Western Prong Township, to serve as constable of said township.
