The meeting was called to order and the Chairman stated the purpose of the meeting was the consideration of the Budget for the Sheriff's Department. The Chairman asked the Sheriff to present the newly revised Budget that was requested at the July 17, 1972, meeting designating certain items by line entries. The Sheriff had not prepared such a document but gave some items orally. After a discussion Commissioner Watts restated his motion which was tabled at an earlier meeting:

Ordered: that the Board approve the Sheriff's Budget as revised and presented at the July 17, 1972, meeting in which he could purchase fourteen 1970 Model used cars to be used by twelve deputies, the Sheriff and the Supt. of the Bu. of Identification. The vote was taken by the Chairman as follows: Voting YES were Commissioners Gore and Watts. Voting NO were Commissioners Burns and Johnson. Chairman Williamson broke the tie vote by voting NO and the order did not pass.

Ordered: that a check be given from the Out-Door-Poor Fund in the amount of \$25.00 each to Dolphus Fowler and James Malone.

Upon motion of Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Commissioner Watts the meeting adjourned until July 28, 1972, at 8:00 p.m. to continue work on unfinished business.
