The meeting was called to order and the following business was transacted:

Ordered: that Martin Carter, Chadbourn, be appointed to replace Robert L. Duncan as Zoning Officer in the Southeastern Community College Area. Mr. Duncan resigned July 27th.

Ordered: that Yvonne B. Ray be granted maternity leave from January 1, 1973 through March 31, 1973.

Ordered: that the County observe the following holidays: October 23rd - Veterans' Day; November 7th - Election Day; November 23rd and 24th - Thanksgiving Holiday.

Ordered: that the following names be submitted to the Cape Fear Council of Governments to be considered as representatives of Columbus County on the Health Planning Council: Autrey Dawsey, Whiteville; Ralph Rogers, Whiteville; E. W. Williamson, Cerro Gordo; Vernell Gibbs, Fair Bluff; John Bennett, Whiteville; Clyde Wayne, Brunswick; Dr. J. R. Mr. Clyde Wayne, Vice-Chairman, Board of Trustees of Columbus County Hospital, came before the Board regarding purchasing property joining the hospital grounds. Mr. Tate, Chairman, was unable to attend because of ill health. After a discussion the following motion was passed:

A motion was made by Commissioner Watts, seconded by Commissioner Johnson, and duly passed to grant to the Board of Trustees of Columbus County Hospital the authority to negotiate with Mrs. Doris Pridgen in an official way for the purchase of property adjoining the present hospital grounds for the purpose of expanding the present hospital.
